Using Your Bins and Boxes



Your bins and boxes can be used to collect your waste and recycling, as below.

- Rinse bottles and cans before putting them in the blue box.
- No more than one standard size bag of additional waste will be collected with the grey wheelie bin.
- We will not return to empty green bins or blue boxes that have not been presented for collection, as this is not cost effective or environmentally viable.
- Please do not use the blue boxes and green bins for waste that is not on the list of items that can be recycled, this can cause problems during the recycling process.

Using Your Bins and Boxes



Use your bins and boxes safely.

- Follow the user guide printed on the side of the recycling box.
- Full wheelie bins should be moved using both hands.



Present your bins, bags or boxes at the kerbside by 7am.

- The collection point is normally at the boundary of your property in view of the road, although it may be at another agreed location.
- Ensure they are not causing an obstruction.



We will sort your glass, cans and paper at the kerbside.

- If the green bin or recycling boxes contain materials not listed this may result in the bin or box not being emptied.
- A Non-Collection Advice card will be left for your reference.



After collection the lid will be left in the box to show it has been emptied.

- Different crews collect the blue boxes and green bins.



Remember to retrieve your bins and boxes after emptying.

- Bins and boxes can be cleaned using warm, soapy water.
- Wrapping your waste can help keep your grey bin clean.

We will not return for grey bins or waste bags that were not presented for collection
