Using the Recycling Banks



The recycling banks can be used for the following materials:

Cans	Steel and aluminium cans
Cardboard	Clean, flattened cardboard
Glass	Glass bottles and jars
Oxfam	Books, CDs and DVDs
Paper	Newspapers, magazines, comics, leaflets, brochures, telephone directories, Yellow Pages and soft-backed catalogues
Plastic Bottles	Household plastic bottles and containers
Plastic Bags	Empty plastic bags, plastic envelopes
Salvation Army	Clothing and shoes
Scope	Clothing and shoes
Shoes	Paired and bagged shoes

Your Local Recycling Centres

Not all banks are at all sites. These banks are for domestic recycling only.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY OTHER MATERIALS IN THE COLLECTION BANKS

The waste materials left in the banks are collected by local merchants and then used for the manufacture of new products. Please follow these guidelines when recycling to ensure the best use can be made of your recycled materials.

- **Sort materials carefully and use the appropriate bank**
- **Rinse cans**
- **Rinse glass bottles and jars**
- **Sort glass into clear, brown and green, with other colours going in the green section**
- **Remove lids from glass bottles and jars, they cannot be recycled**
- **Wash and squash plastic bottles and containers. Do not mix bottles and bags**
- **Please do not leave your recyclable materials at the side of the banks, they may be removed with the rubbish and not recycled**

Please show consideration to residents living close to the facilities, use the banks between 8am and 8pm.

Please do not leave litter at the Recycling Centre, help keep the area tidy and report any problems to South Lakeland District Council on 0845 050 4434.
