Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision to adopt the South Lakeland Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any challenge must be on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared within powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
