Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulation 2004, notice is given that Copeland Borough Council formally adopted the Cumbria Wind Energy Supplementary Planning Document on 22nd January 2008.

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) sets out the Council's policy for assessing proposals for non-domestic wind energy developments in the area of Copeland outside the Lake District National Park.
