# Public Consultation Meeting

## Questions for the Public

### Priorities

The Council has refreshed its Corporate Plan and confirmed its priorities as set out (on the wall). Do you agree that these are the areas the Council should be concentrating on?

### Council Tax

The proposed increase in the level of Council Tax in the 2010/11 Draft Budget for SLDC's portion is 3%. 1% generates £78k.

What do you think it should be? How do you suggest the cost is met?

### Savings Options

Three quarters of a million pounds savings have been delivered by a restructured and the reduction

of 55 posts from April 2010. Another three quarters has been saved through the generation of more income and efficiencies. This has avoided front line services to date but more will be needed in future years and this is likely to affect these.

Which services would you suggest the Council invest less in? (eg Leisure and Recreation, Grants to organisations, Public Conveniences, TICs?)

### Growth

The Council is bound to spend on areas arising from new legislation and health and safety issues. This growth has been included.
