Re South Lakeland Core Strategy

Further to your letter dated 12th May regarding the above, I have listed below some of my concerns regarding both the document and any proposed changes.

A To change the policy restrictions if properties have not sold after 6 months is far too soon, should the properties have been built in the first place if there is no demand after such a short period? existing properties on the market now cannot sell in many cases that quick.

C Should it be necessary to reduce the number at Ulverston , so as not to upset Barrow, this CANNOT be simply added to other areas as it will surely not assist people who live and work in Ulverston to be told to buy a house in Kendal or Kirby Lonsdale.

JUST REDUCE THE SUPPLY TO MEET THE DEMAND!

D Listen to people in Key Service areas and their Parish Councils rather than dictate numbers of homes to be built.

F Planners MUST look at the poor access roads and services in the villages regarding the impact of large housing development.

Has any account been taken of the possibility of the current government cancelling the whole poorly thought through housing scheme, these proposals are not the best use of the limited resources that have been provided by tax payers!

I hope these views will be considered before this area is overrun with too much empty housing.
