Thank you for the opportunity to comment upon the Inspector's Possible Changes as set out in document ED50.

The Trust's comments are brief and for convenience are set out below in this e-mail...

IPC3 CS3.1 Ulverston and Furness Area

I have been unable to find precise details of the extent of the change proposed - my understanding is that a "modest" reduction is proposed in the number of houses to be built in Ulverston over the plan period. It would appear that the knock-on implications in terms of additional houses to be built in Kendal and/or other Key and Local Service Centres should not be unduly high; however, given the concerns raised about the ability of some locations (especially the Local Service Centres) to satisfactorily accommodate the additional development that has been contemplated it is to be hoped that there will not be a significant additional requirement.

IPC4 CS6.1 The Housing Requirement

In large measure this proposed alteration to remove the settlement split for Key Service Centres accords with the Trust's formal representation on the Submitted Core Strategy. Accordingly this possible change is welcomed. It is considered that the Trust's reasoning as set out in its representation remains sound. The Trust is therefore pleased to support the Inspector's Possible Change ref IPC4.
