The Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended)

Regulation 19: Submission of the Community Infrastructure Levy Charging Schedule

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 3 December 2014 South Lakeland District Council submitted a Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Schedule to the Secretary of State for independent examination of its compliance with the above regulations.

CIL is a charge that councils can place on development. Its purpose is to help fund the infrastructure to support development proposed in the Local Plan. A proportion of CIL receipts are passed to Parish and Town Councils for communities to spend on local infrastructure projects. The CIL must strike an appropriate balance between obtaining contributions to funding infrastructure and not putting development at risk by making it financially unviable.

The submission documents comprise the Draft Charging Schedule, Reg 19 (1,b) Representations Statement, representations made on the Draft Charging Schedule and relevant evidence documents.
