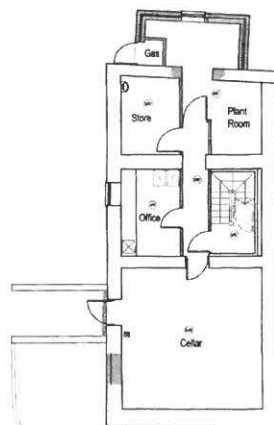

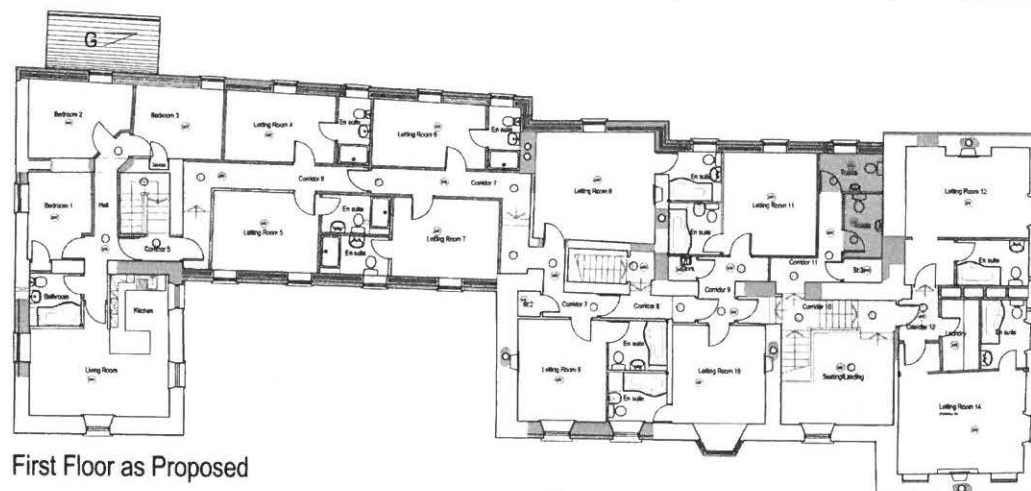
Location Plan 1:2500



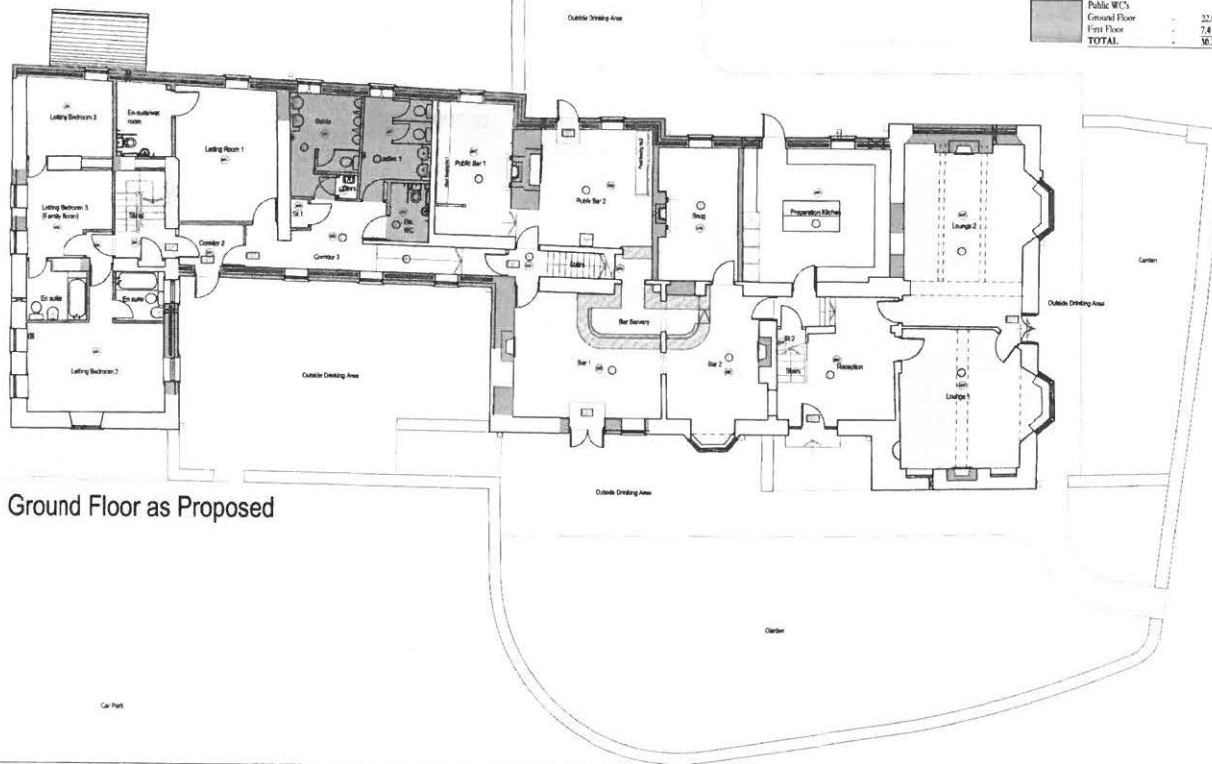
Site Plan 1:500

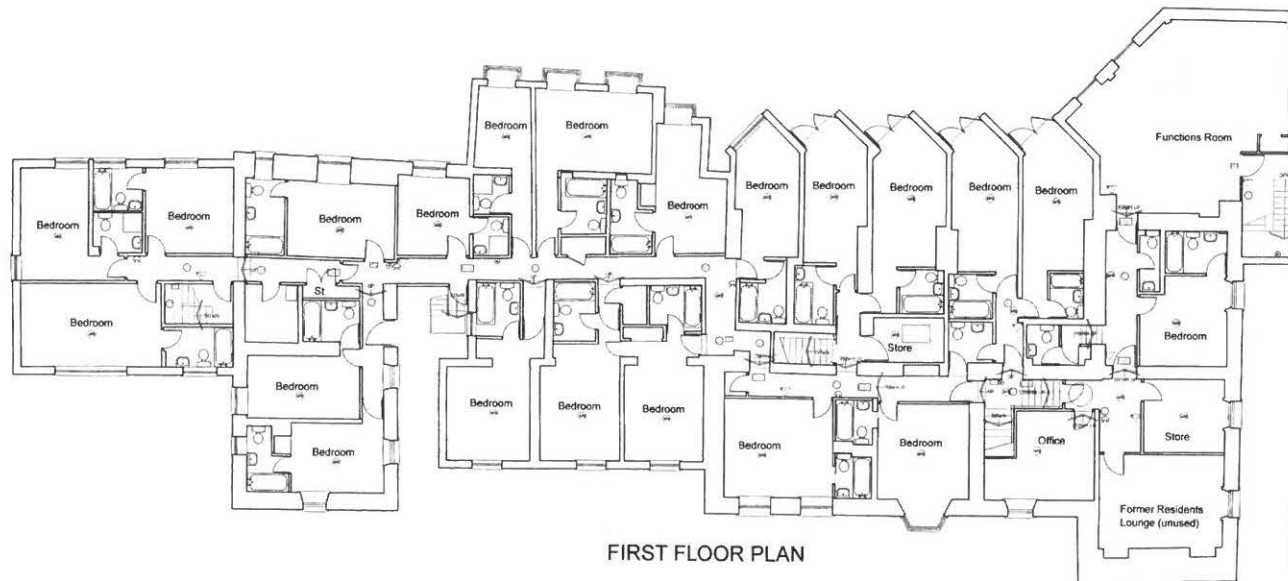

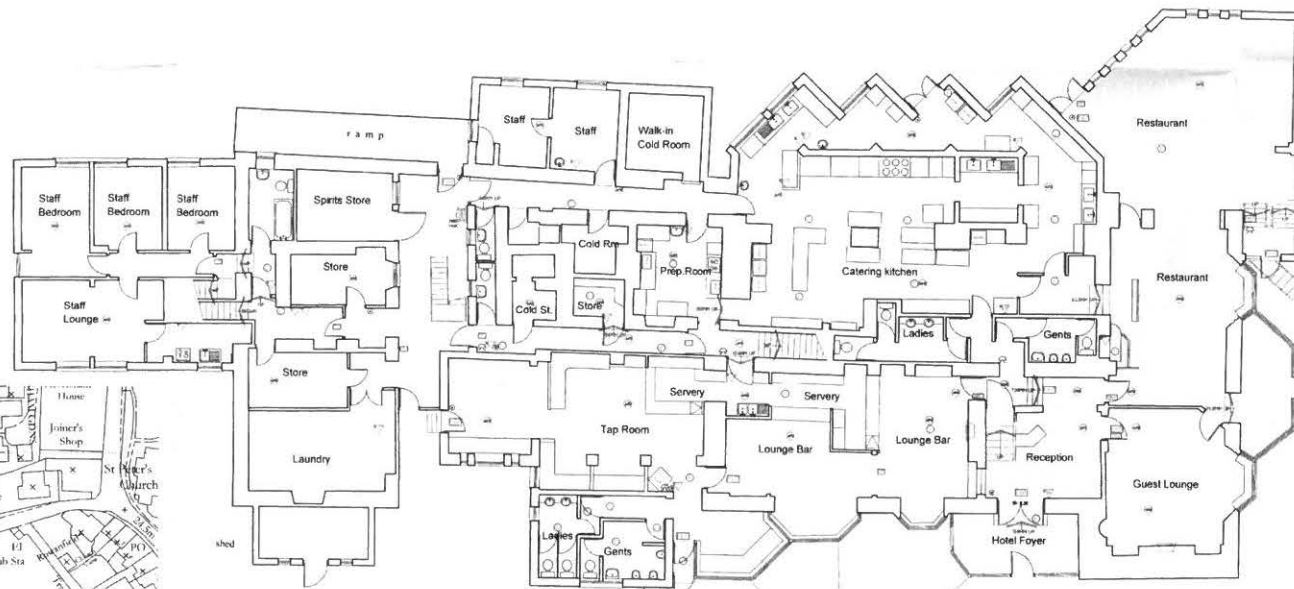

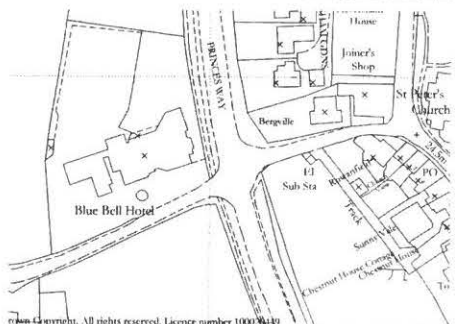
