The premises will operate throughout the day as a community premises with the availability of food and alcohol.

The premises will operate in the evening economy as a nightclub with significant food provision and relaxed atmosphere on lower ground floor with themed areas to the upper floors for the operation of a night time economy premises.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV

a) A CCTV system shall be installed which will be compliant with the requirements and recommendations of Cumbria Constabulary.

b) CCTV recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer of the South Lakeland District or a Police Officer upon request as is reasonably practicable and in any case within 24 hours.

c) Any subject access request shall be compliant with the provisions of the Data Protection Act and shall be pursuant to an investigation of crime and disorder.

d) Notices confirming CCTV systems are in operation shall be displayed at the premises.

SIA Registered door staff

- a) A requirement for the use of Security Industry Authority Registered Door Supervisor shall be risk assessed by the management of the premises.
- b) Cognizance shall be taken of Police intelligence when determining whether Door Supervisors should be deployed for specific events occurring within the vicinity of the premises.
- c) One door person to be on duty when the premises open at 22:00, a further two at 23:00 rising to a minimum of two further door staff per further hundred persons with a maximum of 8 door staff to be deployed at capacity.
- d) Where Door Supervisors are employed a register shall be maintained confirming the full name and Security Industry Authority badge number and time of deployment. The register shall be signed by each Supervisor confirming the hours worked and the register shall be retained for a period of not less than one calendar year.
- e) A separate register shall be maintained by the Designated Premises Supervisor/Manager identifying the name, address, date of birth and SIA Registered badge number of each Supervisor employed by the premises. The register shall be retained for a period of not less than one calendar year.
- A drugs policy shall be in place at the premises.
- An incident book shall be maintained at the premises in which all incidents of crime and disorder shall be recorded. The book shall be reviewed by the Designated Premises Supervisor weekly.

c) Public safety

- Staff shall be trained in respect of their responsibilities with regard to the sale of alcohol
- No person will allowed access to the premises with bottles or glasses
- No person shall be allowed to leave the premises with a glass or bottle
- No person who is subject to a Town Banning Order shall be allowed access to the premises.
- Staff will be available for glass collection throughout the premises to ensure that glasses are not left at tables.
- A dispersal policy shall be in place to ensure an orderly transition at the end of the evening.
- Signs will be displayed throughout the premises that random earches shall take place and those refusing to be searched shall not be allowed access.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

 Notices shall be displayed requesting patrons to leave the premises quietly and respect the environment in which the premises are situated.

e) The protection of children from harm

- A challenge 25 policy shall be in operation at the premises. Acceptable forms of identification shall be passport, driving licence with photo ID and UK Armed Forces Warrant Card
- Children will be allowed on the premises until 18:00 after which time they must be accompanied by an adult.
