Development Briefs Phase 3A: Adoption of Two Development Briefs (Supplementary Planning Documents) – Green Dragon Farm (Burton-in-Kendal) and North of Sycamore Close (Endmoor).

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday 30 August 2017 South Lakeland District Council adopted Development Briefs (Supplementary Planning Documents) for the two above-listed sites. The Development Briefs are now part of the Local Plan for South Lakeland outside the National Parks. The principle of development on these sites was set through the Local Plan Land Allocations.

Development Briefs provide site specific planning guidance on large, complex or sensitive allocated sites. They inform developers and other interested groups of the constraints and opportunities presented by a site and the type of development expected or encouraged on the site by the Local Planning Authority. As Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs), the adopted Development Briefs are material considerations when determining any planning application submitted for the sites. The Adoption Statement, adopted Development Briefs, Consultation Statements and associated information can be inspected on the Council's website www.southlakeland.gov.uk/development-briefs and at the following locations during normal opening hours:

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of any of the Development Brief SPDs may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPDs were adopted (i.e. 30 August 2017).
