Adoption Statement October 2010

This Statement has been prepared in accordance with Reg. 24(2) and Reg. 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and gives notice that on 14 October the District Council resolved to adopt its Core Strategy DPD with effect from 20 October 2010.

The Core Strategy DPD sets out a strategic vision and policies to guide the growth of the District up to the year 2025 and forms part of the South Lakeland Local Development Framework (LDF). It relates to South Lakeland District outside the Lake District and Yorkshire Dales National Park.

The adopted Core Strategy DPD incorporates the binding recommendations of an independent Inspector as part of a Public Examination held in March 2010. Copies of this Adoption Statement, the Core Strategy DPD, the Sustainability Appraisal, and the Inspector's Report are available for public inspection on the Council's website at

- and also during normal opening hours at South Lakeland House (Kendal), Ulverston Town Hall, and libraries at Arnside, Grange over Sands, Kendal, Kirkby Lonsdale, Milnthorpe and Ulverston.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or;
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

An application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than the end of the period of six weeks of the date of the adoption of this Core Strategy, i.e. by 2 December 2010.
