Under The Prevention of Crime & Disorder objective, there is a condition which states "Doorstaff on the premises – Friday and Saturday only, from 23.30 until 02.10 the next day." The Applicant wishes to remove this condition. If the condition cannot be removed the Applicant wishes to have this requirement reduced so that door staff only need to be on premises between 00.30 and 02.10. We enclose a letter from Police Constable following a meeting the Applicant had with her in November 2017.

The full reasons that the Applicant gives in support of removing the condition are stated in paragraphs a) to e) on page 1 of the letter. The Applicant has taken positive steps to improve the safety at his premises and this can be seen in the discussion of the police incidents recorded at the premises.

Again, under The Prevention of Crime & Disorder objective, there is a condition which states "No more than 15 customers to be in the shop at any one time." Having recently acquired the adjoining premises and extended the premises, there is now seating for up to 25 customers. The Applicant would like to vary this condition. The Applicant would like to be able to have more than 25 customers in the premises at any one time.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

The Applicant is aware of his responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003. The Applicant has made positive changes at the premises. Staff are trained and know when to contact the police in order to assist with any issues that arise. There is CCTV in the premises. Having undergone development and increased the size of the premises, this has provided more space for customers

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The Applicant is an active member of the local barwatch scheme. There is CCTV on the premises which is operated by the staff working in the premises.

c) Public safety

and reduced conflict.

There is a first aid box on the premises. There are fire extinguishers on the premises. The staff are trained to spot unwanted behaviour and know when to contact the police for assistance in order to diffuse any potential incidents.

With the increased inside space, there is more room for people so this reduces any potential conflict.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Customers are encouraged to leave quietly and signs are on the doors and walls reminding people to leave the premises quietly and respect the neighbours.

The staff are able to call taxis for customers to ensure they are moved off the premises quickly and quietly.

There is a mobile litter bin outside the shop which is regularly checked and emptied by staff.

e) The protection of children from harm

Due to the nature of the business, children do not usually attend the shop the licensable activity is being carried out. However, in any event, there are no gaming machines on the premises and no cigarette machines on the premises.

Notes for Guidance

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable for the late night levy
- 2. Describe the premises. For example, the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives.  - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
