TRAILERED BOAT PARKING AT FERRY NAB-TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Boat storage within the slipway complex at Ferry Nab is available in line with the following conditions.

The spaces available for the different types of craft are limited and bookings are taken on a first come first served basis.

Boats are to be positioned on arrival at Ferry Nab only after discussion with duty staff at the slipway office.

Third Party Insurance is compulsory and the applicant assures the Council that their vessel is insured for the purpose of storage at Ferry Nab.

All boats, trailers and any associated equipment are left entirely at the owners own risk and the Council accepts no responsibility whatsoever for loss of or damage to any such property.

In the case of vessels requiring launching by a towing vehicle, then launching is only permissible during the normal opening hours of the slipway.

The storage charge is paid in addition to a launching fee.

Parking of vehicles within the compound, except for loading/unloading, is not permitted and vehicles should be removed to the car park, where a parking ticket will need to be obtained.
