Prosecco or Cava), offering liqueur coffees and hot chocolates and small numbers of local bottled beers. We are open between the hours of 10.00 and 18.00 and all outdoor seating is removed and placed inside on closing.

# a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

Risk Assessments are in place regarding movements of customers and staff in and out of the premises.

Staff will be trained to adopt the Challenge 25 policy and to refuse selling or seek advice before selling to anyone they are unsure about age or drunkenness.

Our own objective is to serve low numbers of alcohol to complement our food offer such as afternoon teas and sandwiches. We do not serve pub style meals. Our outdoor tables and seats are taken inside every night to prevent next doors pub customers using them and creating a larger drinking area.

# b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will operate a drinks with food only policy to discourage excessive consumption. Staff will liaise with each other and on duty supervisor with regards to anti-social or criminal behaviour and contact Police immediately with any concerns.

There is no CCTV installed in the premises.

We will have a refusal / incident register which will be kept and available for 1 year. Staff will be trained on our Licensing Act responsibilities as regards, the sale of alcohol, The Age verification policy, Permitted licensing activities, Opening times and the four licensing objectives

#### c) Public safety

Any glass breakages will be cleaned by staff immediately. Staff are First Aid trained and Company Director is a former Nurse. Any medical emergencies and services will be called. The entrance/ exit door and walkways and stairs will be kept clear from obstructions and /or hazards

We operate a seated only service. Customers will not be allowed to stand while consuming food or drink. We are a small, low ceiling building.

A suitably equipped First Aid Kit will be available at the premises.

All staff are aware of emergency evacuation procedures

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

We will operate during reasonable hours (10.00 to 18.00) as we are located next to private dwellings and holiday cottages.

We will only serve alcohol with food.

There will be no excessive loud music on premises only background recorded music. We will not serve alcohol to anyone we believe is drunk or under the influence of drugs. Our outdoor seating is taken inside each night reducing potential 'spreading' of drinking crowds from the pub next door.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

We will operate Challenge 25 policy and also will not serve alcohol to anyone we believe is purchasing for anyone under 18.

We will not allow children on our premises without an adult.

We will operate a drinks with food only policy and discourage 'session drinking' to help avoid inappropriate behavior. Staff will all be trained as regards challenging for proof of age and acceptable evidence of proof

Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
  - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
    - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
  - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
  - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
  - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
  - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

- A Permanent Residence Card issued by the Home Office to the family member of a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.
- A **current** Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder indicating that the person named is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK.

- A certificate of registration or naturalisation as a British citizen, when produced in
  combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance
  number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A **current** passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and is currently allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder which indicates that the named person can currently stay in the UK and is allowed to work relation to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A current Residence Card issued by the Home Office to a person who is not a national of
  a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a
  national or who has derivative rights or residence.
- A current Immigration Status Document containing a photograph issued by the Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person may stay in the UK, and is allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A Certificate of Application, **less than 6 months old**, issued by the Home Office under regulation 17(3) or 18A (2) of the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006, to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence.
- Reasonable evidence that the person has an outstanding application to vary their permission to be in the UK with the Home Office such as the Home Office acknowledgement letter or proof of postage evidence, or reasonable evidence that the person has an appeal or administrative review pending on an immigration decision, such as an appeal or administrative review reference number.
- Reasonable evidence that a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence in exercising treaty rights in the UK including:-
  - evidence of the applicant's own identity such as a passport,
  - evidence of their relationship with the European Economic Area family member e.g. a marriage certificate, civil partnership certificate or birth certificate, and
  - evidence that the European Economic Area national has a right of permanent residence in the UK or is one of the following if they have been in the UK for more than 3 months:
  - (i) working e.g. employment contract, wage slips, letter from the employer,
  - (ii) self-employed e.g. contracts, invoices, or audited accounts with a bank,

- (iii) studying e.g. letter from the school, college or university and evidence of sufficient funds; or
- (iv) self-sufficient e.g. bank statements.

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form.

**Original documents must not be sent to licensing authorities.** If the document copied is a passport, a copy of the following pages should be provided:-

- (i) any page containing the holder's personal details including nationality;
- (ii) any page containing the holder's photograph;
- (iii) any page containing the holder's signature;
- (iv) any page containing the date of expiry; and
- (v) any page containing information indicating the holder has permission to enter or remain in the UK and is permitted to work.

If the document is not a passport, a copy of the whole document should be provided.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.
