a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

A digital CCTV camera system, which shall include 'facial recognition' capable of providing evidential quality images in all lighting conditions shall be used at all times when licensable activities are taking place. Images will be retained for a minimum period of 28 days and be made available to the Police and Licensing Authority upon request by authorised officers.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The company due diligence policy includes the operation of internal test purchases. The EPOS till scanning system prompt will alert the staff on the till to check the age of the customer when purchasing age-restricted products. A suitable Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) system will be operational at the premises at all times when licensable activities are being carried out and at any other times where members of the public are present on the premises and will retain images for a period of 28 days. The images will be available upon reasonable request from a responsible authority.

c) Public safety

Staff will monitor the area immediately outside the premises on a regular basis to check for, and properly dispose of, any litter.

The store operates a manual refusals log and also a due diligence recording system by way of the EPOS till with regard to age-restricted products. An age checking report is available in store where refusals of service are made.

The premises will adhere to the regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. Appropriate fire safety equipment shall be available.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Staff will monitor the area immediately outside the premises on a regular basis to check for, and properly dispose of, any litter.

The store operates a manual refusals log and also a due diligence recording system by way of the EPOS till with regard to age-restricted products. An age checking report is available in store where refusals of serve are made.

e) The protection of children from harm

All staff employed in the sale of alcohol will be fully trained to at least level 1 BIIAB or equivalent and all staff involved in the sale of age restricted products will receive "in house" training and will be re-trained as a minimum every 13 weeks. We operate the challenge 25 policy and anyone who appears to be under the age of 25 will be asked for proof of age, to ensure that only persons over 18 years of age are sold alcohol. All members of staff at the premises shall seek credible photographic proof of age evidence from any such person who appears to be under the age of 25 years and who is seeking to purchase alcohol. Such identification includes a passport, photographic driving licence, military ID or an accredited proof of age card.

All staff responsible for selling age restricted goods are trained to implement the company age verification policy.



Notes for Guidance

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable for the late night levy
- 2. Describe the premises. For example, the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives. Where your application includes off-supplies of alcohol and you intend to provide a place of consumption of these off-supplies of alcohol, you must include a description of where the place will be and its proximity to the premises.
- 3. In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:
 - Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
 - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
